



Back to Basics: Why the Fundamentals Still Matter

Every so often in life, it's important to return to the basics. Athletes go back to fundamentals of form and conditioning. Musicians revisit scales and exercises. Teachers return to foundational skills before moving to advanced material. Even the most seasoned professional needs a reminder of what really matters most.

The same is true for our life of faith. Over time, we can get so caught up in the busyness of church activities, programs, and schedules that we lose sight of the core practices that shape us as disciples of Jesus Christ. That's why our current sermon series, Back to Basics, is so important. We are revisiting the foundational rhythms of worship, prayer, mission, Scripture, the sacraments, and hospitality— not because we've forgotten them, but because we need to be reminded of how vital they are.

John Wesley, the founder of Methodism, often spoke of the "means of grace"— ordinary practices through which God does extraordinary work in us. Worship, prayer, serving our neighbors, Bible study, sharing in the sacraments, and practicing hospitality are not optional add-ons to the Christian life. They are the very tools God uses to shape our hearts and transform the world. For when we return to the basics, we are renewed. We remember who God is and who we are called to be. We find strength for daily living and courage to face challenges. And we open ourselves once again to the grace of God that is always available, always reaching, always calling us deeper.

So whether you are new to the faith, have been along the journey for a while, or somewhere in between, this is a season for renewal. My hope is that each of us will take this opportunity not only to listen on Sunday mornings, but also to practice these basics throughout the week. Because these simple, powerful practices are what keep us rooted in God's love and ready to share that love with the world.


